Subject: Integration of central Government Payment System with NGO DARPAN Portal of Niti Aayog and related action- instructions regarding.

Reference: Finance Department OM No. FD-VII-3(48)2019 dated 04-04-2021.

NGO DARPAN is a Platform that provides space for interface between Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)/Voluntary Organizations (VOs) in the country and the key Government Ministries/Departments/Government bodies. It was rolled out as an initiative of the PM's office to create and promote a healthy partnership between NGOs/VOs and Government of India. It is an e-governance application offered by NITI Aayog to maintain Data and transparency electronically regarding NGOs/VOs in the country.

In order to transact business with line Ministries /departments an NGO has to sign up on the NGO DARPAN portal to obtain unique identity number (UIN) by furnishing the required details like registration number of the organization, PAN of the organization, PAN and AADHAR details of the office bearers/Trustee etc.

Accordingly, All the Treasury Officers of UT of J&K while releasing the funds/payments to NGOs/VOs shall ensure that they have received agency details alongwith NGO DARPAN ID from PFMS for transfer of funds/payments in the same bank accounts which is registered in PFMS for that particular agency.
