**C I R C U L A R**

It has been observed that the cheques issued by the DDOs in favour of Contractors, suppliers and Firms etc issued during the last days of March are received in the treasuries throughout during the month of April and some times as late as in the month of May. This late presentation of cheques at the treasuries by the DDOs or the Contractors disturbs the cash management system and payments in favour of the beneficiaries get delayed.

In order to streamline expenditure and ensure greater transparency , the Treasury Officers are advised not to entertain any Government cheque for the financial year 2015-16 under any circumstances or explanation thereof after 5<sup>th</sup> of April, 2016 payable to Contractors, Suppliers and Firms etc.

The Treasury officers will advise the Cheque Drawing DDOs accordingly. Any Treasury officers deviating from these instructions shall be liable for strict disciplinary action.
