Subject:-Switching over to e-Stamping

CIRCULAR

Government of UT of J&K vide S.O 201 dated 24.06.2020 has decided to switch over to e-Stamping mechanism which is being rolled out in entire UT of J&K. In order to prevent any inconvenience to the stamp duty payers during the transition period the Government vide Government order no.234-FD of 2020 dated:-27.08.2020 has allowed the payments of stamp duty through Challan in concerned treasuries on endorsement by officer authorised under section 10(4) of Stamp Act, Samvat 1977. The document shall be got endorsed by the concerned State Taxation Officer/Sub-Division Magistrate of the area before being presented to the registering authority for registration.

It is enjoined upon all the Treasury Officers dealing with stamps to accept the payments of stamp duty through Challan and report the sale/receipts of stamps to the District Treasury Officer concerned at the end of each working, who in turn shall share the same with the concerned State Taxation Officer/Sub-Division Magistrate of that area and Deputy Commissioner Stamps Jammu/Kashmir in case of Treasuries of Jammu and Srinagar District as the case may be. Further it shall also be ensured by the Treasury Officers that stamp duty payers shall not be entitled to any commission/discount.
