Subject: Submission of Property Returns by Public Servants.

CIRCULAR

As per provisions of Jammu and Kashmir, Public Men and Public Servants, Declaration of Assets and other Provisions Act, 1983, amended thereafter from time to time, every Public Servant has to submit to the Prescribed Authority, a return of all the assets possessed by him/her and his/her family members within three months after he/she becomes a Public Servant and thereafter submit annual returns of the assets held by him/her and his/her family members in the month of January every year and shall state the reasons for increase, if any, in the assets and source thereof.

In order to ensure adherence to the instructions contained in the aforesaid Act and as pointed out by the Director, Anti Corruption Bureau, all Departmental Vigilance Officers (DVOs) are directed to impress upon all officers/Officials borne on the establishment of Jammu and Kashmir Accounts Service to submit copy of their Annual Property Return duly filled in for the year 2020 to Anti Corruption Bureau without further delay.

The Members who fail to comply with the instructions shall be dealt in accordance with standing rules without any further correspondence in this behalf.
