**Subject: OA No 420/2024, titled Imtiyaz Ahmad Bhat V/s UT of J&K and Others.**

**Government Order No. 347-F of 2024**

**DATED 11.11.2024**

Whereas, J&K Services Selection Board, vide no. JKSSB-Scry/5/2024-03(7415959) dated 10.03.2024, furnished the Final selection list of candidates for the post of Accounts Assistants in pursuance of Advertisement No. 04 of 2020, in which the recommendation in respect of one of the applicants namely Imtiyaz Ahmad Bhat S/o Ab. Rashid Bhat, had been kept withheld subject to production of valid RBA certificate;

Whereas, the applicant filed OA No 420/2024, titled Imtiyaz Ahmad Bhat V/s UT of J&K and Others, in the Hon'ble Tribunal, Srinagar Bench wherein he prayed as under:

- a) *Order/direction, directing the Respondents to release the recommendations of the Applicant for the Post of Accounts Assistant under RBA Category, pursuant to Advertisement Notice No. 04 of 2020 dated 16.12.2020, to the Respondent No.1 and 2 without any further delay;*
- b) *Further directing the respondent No.1 and 2 to issue formal appointment Orders in favour of the Applicant against the Post of Accounts Assistant under RBA Category pursuant to Advertisement supra and also allow him to join against the said Post without any further delay and release and all the consequential benefits in favour of the Petitioner/Applicant.*

Whereas, OA was disposed of by the Hon'ble Tribunal vide Order dated 15.07.2024 with following directions: -

*“The petition is accordingly disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner in the light of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court of J&K as well as by this Tribunal, provided the petitioner is similarly circumstanced as of those to which reference has been made by the petitioner in the judicial pronouncements cited by the petitioner. It is expected that the respondents will consider the case of the petitioner within a reasonable period of four weeks' time as on date the copy of the judgment is served upon the respondents”*

Whereas, the Finance Department is the indenting Department for the post of Accounts Assistant with the mandate to appoint those candidates whose recommendations are received from the Recruiting Agency which in this case is J&KSSB.

Whereas, no such recommendation for appointment in favour of the petitioner has been received from J&K SSB.

Now, therefore, in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal in OA No. 420/2024 titled Imtiyaz Ahmad Bhat V/s UT of J&K and Others, the claim of the applicant has been examined in light of facts and circumstances mentioned above and found devoid of merits; Hence rejected.
