- iv. The official shall submit final claim in Form -3 within one month from date of return journey after availing LTC.
- v. Journey to Pune is performed by the shortest route.
- vi. Dependence of family members upon the official is established by the concerned DDO under rules.
- vii. The entitlement is regulated by concerned DDO under rules.


